

Croyland Primary School – PE and Sports Funding 2017/18

Rationale

Our year started with a whole school sports initiative: Skip2B fit. The reason was to ensure that the promotion of a healthy lifestyle with fitness at its core. This was accessed by all pupils, even if they didn't see themselves as sports people. We bought each child a school skipping rope and each class is competing against one another in a leader board of fitness. Pupils take their skipping ropes out at play and practise without pressure of competition but they can see themselves how they are improving with practise and stamina growth. The SKIp2B fit monthly event is embedded to our school calendar.

Through last year, we developed a positive relationship with Claire Standcliff through investing in Northamptonshire Sport. Previously we had been troubled by the quality of the coaches that we had hired due to our high expectations of behaviour management. They sports coaches but did not have a teaching tool kit to address the challenges of fully inclusive school.

Claire has captained GB Woman's Deaf football team. Her role with us has given us confidence again with using external coaches. Her focus was inclusion of all and an enjoyment. She has been booked in for a year of sports coaching. She demonstrated to our pupils that a physical disability doesn't hinder your access to professional sport and that there this huge range of sports and opportunities out there for pupils.

This has made us think hard about what our core offer is and widening our pupil's knowledge of the true meaning of being a sports man. We hope this will give some of our reluctant pupils a greater motivation and aspiration into an area of the curriculum that they had previously shied away from.
