



At Croyland Primary school, we use TT Rockstars to learn and practice our times table facts. TT Rockstars is a carefully sequenced programme of daily times tables practice. This should be completed three times a week for homework, and all children have a login that is in their reading record.

We have also recently signed up to a similar programme from the makers of TT Rockstars called NumBots. This program is aimed at Key Stage 1 pupils, or any child who needs help developing their mental calculations. NumBots is all about every child achieving the “triple win” of understanding, recall and fluency in mental addition and subtraction, so that they move from counting to calculating, which is essential as children progress from Year 1 to Year 2, and then into Key Stage 2.



Spelling Shed is an online platform that we use as part of our Spelling Curriculum. Each child has their own log in details, which allows them to access word lists for their year group, and other lists that have been set by their teacher to link with their current spelling topic. It is a fun way for children to practise their spellings. As part of their KS2 homework children are expected to play at least 3 games a week, which teachers can track online.

Each week there are prizes for the top KS1 and KS2 spellers and Croyland Cash and Bean rewards for top KS1 and KS2 classes.

Online Safety

It has come to our attention that lots of children in Key Stage 1 are playing a game called Among Us (PGEI 7). I have therefore put together a summary about the content of game, the potential risks and a set of tips to allow us to optimise our children's safety if they are playing it. 
Please do not park in the disabled parking bays if you come onto the school site to collect or drop off. These are reserved for those with blue badges.
